## Terms & Conditions

By registering for the SFL James Boag's Draught Sprint, the participant accepts the terms and conditions for this event as follows.

### Eligibility to participate:

To be eligible to participate in the SFL James Boag's Draught Sprint the player/umpire must be registered with the SFL.

The player/umpire must complete the entry form and send to their Club President or Secretary to submit with the SFL. A maximum of 2 entries per club/SFLUA are permitted and it is the responsibility of the club/SFLUA to determine who they will nominate to the SFL.

If a participant is under 18 years of age on the date of the SFL James Boag's Draught Sprint, a parent or guardian must accept these terms and conditions.

The participant must be medically and physically fit and able to participate.

### Refusal of applications:

The SFL reserves the right to refuse any application for entry into the SFL James Boag's Draught Sprint. The SFL will confirm with each Club and applicant as to whether their application has been accepted.

### Participant's obligations:

Participants must wear their club / umpire guernsey whilst participating in the SFL James Boag's Draught Sprint.

Participants must wear runners or football boots only.

Spikes are not permitted.

### Competition format:

The SFL James Boag's Draught Sprint will be the same distance over the 4 weeks, approximately 75-90 metres long.

The SFL James Boag's Draught Sprint will occur at half-time of Division 1 Senior games at Springvale Reserve, Newcomen Road Springvale.

The Semi Finals will occur on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> September, the Preliminary Final will occur on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> September and the Grand Final will occur on Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> September.

The SFL will allocate all participants into the semi-finals.

After confirmation of the total participants, the SFL will confirm the qualifying criteria to advance to the preliminary and grand finals.

The SFL will be solely responsible for the running of the SFL James Boag's Draught Sprints and will adjudicate accordingly.

The SFL's decision will at all times be final.

### Prize money:

The Grand Final SFL James Boag's Draught Sprint winner will receive \$1,000.

The Grand Final SFL James Boag's Draught Sprint winner's Club / SFLUA will receive \$500.
