### Netball Court Supervisor

#### Roles & Responsibilities



#### Purpose

- This position will be the responsibility of each home club hosting fixtured netball matches
- The appointed person:
  - may change for each game but not during the game
  - must be familiar with the rules and bylaws, and is mature and competent to make decisions relating to safety on the day
  - shall act in an unbiased manner at all times
  - must not be involved in any other role while acting as Court Supervisor
  - must remain court side for the duration of the game
  - is to wear the supplied high vis vest

#### Duties

- Match Day checklist to be complete and supplied to the SFNL Netball Operations Coordinator prior to the beginning of the first game.
- Ensure scorers and time keepers are in place and aware of the rules and their responsibilities
- Ensure Coaches and team members remain in the designated bench areas
- Attend to and resolve spectator behaviour
- Address any officials, off court players and coaches of breaches of conduct
- Follow up any umpires that are scheduled on the day – umpires for Home Games are to be coordinated by the Home Club (with cooperation from the visiting Club). Should an incident occur where a resolution is unable to be met, the Court Supervisor is to contact the Umpire Head Coach and/or an SFNL representative for guidance of an agreed decision. If neither can be reached, the decision of the Court Supervisor will be deemed to be that of the SFNL.
- Ensure the safety of umpires and the court side is clear for umpire movement during play
- Ensure all rules of Netball Victoria and by laws of the SFNL are adhered to and administered fairly and without bias
- Ensure a copy of the SFNL Bylaws are available court side
- Ensure all scoresheets are completed correctly, and copies provided to the league on the day of competition
- Coordinate any necessary equipment including first aid supplies
