While for East Malvern in their second year back in division two after a luckless 2022 season in division one they now find themselves in the last game of the season ready to perhaps cause a great upset over these rampant Lions.

Of course we will start with a look at Murrumbeena's season. They went a magnificent 17 win and 1 loss record in the home and away season of 2024 with that only loss coming against Doveton away from home way back in round 12.

Their finals campaign so far has only consisted of their semi final win over Doveton which was an ultra impressive win to the tune of 74 points as they kept the Doves to just the one goal on that occasion.

Starting his first season as senior coach Michael Kinsella was lucky enough to have a massive rapport with his players already given he played in last years grand final with a vast majority of these players who take the field today and they've responded to all his calls & demands with class & at times sheer domination over their opponents.

The main headache for East Malvern will be the forward duo of Todd Elton & Steve Tolongs, with 105 goals between them to date it's hard work to keep them down. But then there is Dareo Rogers as well who can play back, mid and in recent weeks down forward with his 32 goals to this day he's turned into a vital player for this Lions side while Sam Michael & Jordan Pollard will be looking to service them all day with clean & precise ball movement.

Over at East Malvern now they've sort of lurked in the shadows in recent weeks. Playing second fiddle to their opponent today as well as Doveton who looked likely to play Murrumbeena today for a large portion of 2024 their preliminary final win oozed the class that this side has shown at multiple stages throughout the season.

Their record of 13-5 on the season has been due reward for Mick Rossborough and his men as they've silenced some of the critics who doubted their abilities to get back to this very important day in the middle of September.

They've done it the hard way too during this finals series. Their qualifying final loss to Doveton must have stung them into life as the next week they defeated Hampton Park by 7 points in ugly conditions and then as mentioned they extracted revenge on the Doves to get here today.

They are spearheaded by massive key forward Isaac Morrisby who has amassed 81 goals to date in season 2024. The man they call 'Moose' has the devastating ability to take opposing sides completely out of the game with his devastating goal kicking ability and will look to do the same today.

While players Jacob Brunner, Robbie Amendola, Patty McNamara, Logan Berryman & Adam Collinson will as always get plenty of the footy and look to be those players to steady the ship if push comes to shove.

In their meetings in 2024, Murrumbeena won their first match up in round 7 by an even two goals while on their second meeting in round 15 the Lions also won that meeting by 24 points. So what will it be today? Will the Lions get their just rewards for a season of dominance and get that promotion to division 1? Or will the Panthers spoil the party and send one of the most decorated & passionate coaches in Mick Rossborough out as a winner? It promises to be a magnificent contest and may the best team win.
