## **WHAT'S CHANGED FOR COACHES?**

AFLID	Existing coaches from 2025 can simply log in to the AFL Learn platform with
	their AFLiD to access their AFL Learn Coach Dashboard. There's no need to re-
	link their AFLiD to AFL Learn.
Inputting WWCC (Working with Children Check) Details	New coaches, or returning coaches who did not coach in 2025, will still need to link their AFLiD with their AFL Learn account during their first login.  For clubs that require their coaches to enter their WWCC details in PlayHQ, coaches no longer need to register separately as a Volunteer in PlayHQ.  New coaches can now login to PlayHQ using their AFLiD, claim their coaching profile, and add their WWCC details in the Child Safety Verification section
	<ul> <li>Returning coaches do not need to make any changes if their WWCC details are up to date. However, they can edit their WWCC details in the Child Safety Verification section of their profile</li> </ul>
My Teams Management Access	Once a club administrator allocates a coach to a team in PlayHQ, that coach will automatically receive management access to My Teams. This gives them the ability to:
	View squad details
	Manage line-ups and game sheets
	Enter scores and player stats (if enabled by the competition)
	Access other team management features
	Coaches can manage <b>multiple teams</b> if allocated to more than one. Assistant coaches and team managers can also be granted access, but this must be enabled by the club administrator.
AFL Learn	Coaches now benefit from a more tailored and intuitive learning experience, with
Coach	the following enhancements to the AFL Learn Coach Dashboard:
Dashboard	<ul> <li>Tailored learning pathways: Coaches can access learning content that directly aligns with the age group they select. Their dashboard is organised by coaching competencies, making it easier to find and engage with relevant modules.</li> <li>Visible progress and recognition: Coaches can now view their earned</li> </ul>
	badges, accumulated points and current coaching tier (Bronze, Silver or Gold) directly on the dashboard.
	<ul> <li>Integrated workshop listings: The dashboard now highlights face-to-face workshops available in each coach's region helping them stay informed and connected to learning opportunities.</li> </ul>
AFL Learn Coach Module	The AFL Learn Coach Module Library is a collection of online learning resources designed to support coaches at all levels — from Auskick to senior community football.
Library	Coach Topic Filter: Easily navigate learning content by filtering modules     based on coaching topics that matter most to you.

## WHAT'S CHANGED FOR CLUB ADMINISTRATORS?

## Area Change My Teams When a club allocates a coach to a team, that **coach automatically Management Access** receives management access to My Teams by default. This enables them to: View squad details Manage line-ups and game sheets Enter scores and player stats (if enabled) Access other team management features. If a coach does not require this level of access, club administrators can manually disable it for individual coaches via the team settings in the admin portal. Coaches can manage multiple teams if allocated to more than one. Assistant coaches and team managers can also be granted access, but this must be enabled by the club administrator. PlayHQ Club Coach Clubs now have a dedicated **PlayHQ Coach Dashboard**, allowing them **Dashboard** to monitor coach registration progress and status ie. This dashboard provides visibility into: Which coaches have registered Their accreditation level Any outstanding registration requirements These insights help clubs streamline coach onboarding, reduce followup admin, and ensure compliance across all coaching roles. **Important:** Only accredited coaches will appear on official team sheets. Clubs should regularly check the dashboard to ensure all coaches have completed their accreditation to avoid last-minute issues on game day.
